  - We recommend all students complete the *Free Application for Federal Student Aid* (FAFSA) form **early** in their senior year
    - U Promise Scholarship (Minnesota families up to \$120,000 household income are eligible)
    - Promise Plus Scholarship (Minnesota families up to \$50,000 household income are eligible)
  - Each campus conducts a merit-based scholarship review

### **UMN Duluth Updates**

- UMD is test-optional for all programs.
- On-Campus Tours are currently available during the week and on select Saturdays.
  - –We've welcomed over 7,000 visitors to campus since Aug. 2020
  - -All visit options can be found at d.umn.edu/visit
  - -Can also check out our virtual map at d.umn.edu/campusmap
  - -Group tours are hosted on select Tuesdays and Wednesdays.
- Encourage students to complete a scholarship profile at <u>raise.me/join/umd</u> no later than Dec. 15.
  - –Students who apply by Oct. 15 are also eligible for our \$500 Early Applicant Scholarship

## **UMN Morris Updates**

- ACT/SAT not required for admission for students entering Fall 2022.
- 96% of our classes are offered in-person.
- Individual virtual visits are available on weekdays.
- On-Campus tours are available 5 times a day, five days a week. Each tour is limited to two families per tour time.

## **UMN Rochester Updates**



- UMR will be test-optional for all programs
- Interviews for all Early Assurance programs & Scholarships will be in person though virtual accommodations will be available
- On Campus Tours are currently available for twice a day.
  - Each tour will be individual with only 1 family
  - Open Houses will be in person but limited capacity
  - Saturday tours now available once a month.

# **Application review**

- All 5 campuses use holistic review
- Individual, overall, holistic assessment of student's application
- Students will not be required to submit an ACT or SAT score on their Fall 2022 undergraduate application to any of the University of Minnesota System campuses due to COVID-19

# Share My App Program

- Must have a complete application at the Twin Cities to share the application with Crookston, Rochester, Morris, or Duluth
- Students will see an invitation to "Share My App" in their Application Tracker after they submit their Twin Cities campus application.
- Additional invitations to participate is sent via email starting in mid-October after students submit their Twin Cities application.
- Consideration at the selected system campuses with no new application or fee

## **Application Review Crookston**

Application: Common App or Golden Eagle Application.

#### To Complete an Application:

- Unofficial high school. transcript (or GED)
- \$30 application fee (\*fee waived through October)

**Test Score Review:** No ACT/SAT needed for admission or scholarship consideration.

#### Deadline: Rolling Admission

Acceptance decisions released within about 1-2 weeks after receiving completed application

#### Spring 2022

• December 15, 2021

#### Fall 2022

- Priority Deadline: February 15, 2022
- Final Deadline: August 1, 2022

### **Additional Information:**

- Accept first-year applicants for Spring and Fall start terms (Fall encouraged)
- RaiseMe scholarship earnings partnership







# Campus Application Review Duluth

Application: UMD application or Common App

**Needed at Time of Application:** HS transcript (or GED), \$40 application fee

Test Score Review: Test Optional (Permanent change)

Deadline: Fall priority – Dec 15, 2021 Fall final – Aug 1, 2022



# Campus Application Review Morris

**Application:** UMN Morris Application or Common App

### Needed at Time of Application:

- Unofficial HS transcript (or GED) or self-reported record
- \$30 online application fee
- App fee waived during month of October for College Knowledge Month; Fee waiver available upon request

Test Score Review: ACT/SAT Test Score Not Required

**Deadline:** Fall priority – Dec. 15, 2021 Fall final – August 1, 2022





# Campus Application Review Rochester

Application: UMR Raptor App or Common App

**Needed at Time of Application:** Official HS transcript (or GED), \$30 application fee

Test Score Review: Test Optional

**Deadlines:** Priority – Dec 1, 2021

Final – July 1, 2022





# **Application Review Twin Cities**

Application: Golden Gopher Application or Common App

Direct admission to one of 8 freshman-admitting colleges

### To Complete An Application:

- Self-Reported Academic Record or Courses and Grades section of Common App
- \$55 app fee (or fee waiver)

**Test Score Review:** ACT/SAT Test Score Not Required for 2022 cycle

  - Final deadline for School of Nursing
- Early Action II: December 1, 2021
- Regular: January 1, 2022




